Made from 80% Grenache, 15% Syrah, and 5% Cinsault, this wine displays a vibrant garnet robe. From the hedonist 2008 vintage in the Rhone Valley, this Cotes du Rhone displays, ripe, soft berry and plum aromas on the nose with a hint pepper underlying the layers of fruit are accompanied by a finely structure mouth with firm, fleshy tan nins.
